The account of the Drexels, like the Astors, starts in the Old World; in Europe. Francis Martin Drexel was born in <u>Dornbirn</u> in the Tyrol area of Austria on April 7, 1792 and lived until June 5, 1863 when he died of injuries sustained in a train accident; it may be that he as a Philadelphia resident and a greedy banker may have worried whether the North would fail to defeat the South in the Civil War, since it hadn't yet been decided. In 1812, he returned to the Tyrol incognito. Conscription was still in force, so he went to Bern. In 1817, he sailed for the United States from Amsterdam, and settled in Philadelphia. After a few years, he went to Peru and Chile, painting portraits, including one of General Simón Bolívar. Drexel visited South America twice as well as Mexico."

Yes! The original Drexel was Catholic, and a streak of Catholicism persisted in this family for decades; which is why I speculate that they are some of the later entrants into The Pilgrims Society, a group sponsored by English Royals, with historic conflicts with the Pope! The first year I can show an Astor in The Pilgrims (NYC) is 1907; the first year I can show a Drexel in The Pilgrims (London) is 1924. The first year I can show a Drexel in The Pilgrims (NYC) is 1969! That is to say, by paternity; there's an Anthony Drexel Biddle Jr. in The Pilgrims NYC in 1957; so the Drexels were represented first as of then. However, I have sketchy details only for 1958 through 1968; most likely John Rozet Drexel III was a Pilgrims member several years before 1969. We're getting ahead of the story line; let's retrace.

According to Wiki on Francis Martin Drexel, the <u>founder</u> of the Drexel family in America---

"In 1837, after his permanent settlement in Philadelphia, he founded the banking house **Drexel & Company which became one of the largest banks in the United States.** The original business of Drexel & Co. was discounting privately issued bank notes, the value of which was largely dependent on the character of the principal officers of the issuing bank. The exposure to the principals gained from portrait painting is said to have given Drexel inside knowledge. After his death in 1863, the Paris firm, Drexel, Harjes & Co., was founded in 1868, and the New York firm, Drexel, Morgan & Co., was founded in 1871."



But the history of J.P. Morgan in France dates back nearly half a century before the firm purchased its celebrated location on Place Vendôme in 1916. In 1868, the firm's earliest predecessor in Paris opened as Drexel, Harjes & Co., a banking firm run by Anthony Drexel whom J. Pierpont Morgan would later partner with in New York.

In 1870, Drexel, Harjes & Co. developed a relationship with Pierpont's father, Junius Morgan, when it assisted with the transfer of funds for Junius' \$50 million loan to the French government during the Franco-Prussian War. One year later, Anthony Drexel and Pierpont Morgan would establish a merchant bank in New York called Drexel, Morgan & Co., later renamed J.P. Morgan & Co.

In 1895, two years after Drexel's death, J.P. Morgan & Co. assumed full control of Drexel, Harjes in Paris and renamed the firm Morgan Harjes & Co., with Pierpont Morgan as its senior partner. As the firm approaches 150 years in Paris, J.P. Morgan stands as one of the longest continuously operating American banks in the country.

In <u>1867</u> with partners John H. Harjes and Eugene Winthrop, Anthony Joseph Drexel opened Drexel, Harjes & Company in Paris France. Drexel, Harjes & Company based in Paris helped <u>finance</u> the Panama Canal. John Harjes (1830-1914) was a boyhood <u>pal</u> of Anthony Joseph Drexel---

"Drexel was in Dornbirn, Austria, and began studying painting in Italy at the age of eleven. When Napoleon seized control of the Tyrol, he was forced to leave school and return to his native city, where he apprenticed to a portrait painter. In 1809, having participated in the unsuccessful Tyrolese revolt, Drexel fled to Switzerland, where he worked as a sign painter. He immigrated to Philadelphia in 1817, exhibiting at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts between 1818 and 1826. He traveled through Mexico and South America, relying on a commission for about 200 miniatures for income. .Drexel returned to Philadelphia in 1830, also having gained first-hand knowledge of foreign banking practices."

The failed Tyrolese Revolt was against the forces of General Napoleon Bonaparte. Not only did the first Drexel in America learn about "foreign banking practices," undoubtedly he acquired large info on the use of precious metals, silver especially, across Mexico and in South America. "Drexel is better known for his second career. After the Second Bank of the United States dissolved, he began speculating in bank notes and founded Drexel & Co. Drexel claimed that he could judge individual character of the men running "Wild Cat" banks by examining their faces - a skill he attributed to his time as a portrait painter. Drexel relocated to Louisville, Kentucky, where he opened a major brokerage house. After the Panic of 1837, **Drexel & Co. emerged as a leading banking house in the country. J.P. Morgan served as junior partner.** Drexel was killed by a train at the age of seventy-two. His son, Anthony Joseph, founded Drexel University. His grand-niece, Katherine Drexel, was the second American-born saint to be canonized, having founded the congregation Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament for Indians and Colored People, and Xavier University in New Orleans."

Thirty four years would pass before J.P. Morgan became affiliated with Anthony Joseph Drexel, Francis M. Drexel's son. More to come on this.

How is it that "after the Panic of 1837" Drexel & Company "emerged as a leading banking house in the country" except that this wily conniving character had connections to the banks causing the Panic of 1837? That Panic was organized for several reasons; 1) to punish the retired President Andrew Jackson for demolishing the second United States Bank; 2) to impoverish the majority, which is always a top goal of organized elites and 3) to blame the Panic of 1837 on the absence of a central bank so still another CB could get a Congressional charter! This led to banking and the founding of the brokerage house of Drexel and Company. His three sons, Francis Anthony, Anthony Joseph, and Joseph William, joined him in the company. He was married to Catherine Hookey."

She seems to have been of French Catholic extraction.

Naturally while others were dying for their independence this social parasite insured he'd be well distanced from battlefronts, same as he chickened out and fled Austria to avoid being drafted! Later on Drexel & Company would help finance the North in the Civil War. Always OK with bankers for others to be brutally massacred, return missing eyeballs, kneecaps, hands, noses and so forth; those matters are joked about in their exclusive by invitation only social clubs! Drexel & Company <u>also</u> "made money in the opportunities created by gold finds in California." Drexel & Company with headquarters in Philadelphia had <u>branches</u> in New York, Chicago and San Francisco and did much business with George Peabody & Company of London.

Francis Drexel chose Louisville for his currency brokerage apparently on the advice of friends he had met in Mexico. His reason for locating there is unknown, but an observer can hazard an educated guess. Louisville lay in the heart of the western states whose banks were most starved for gold and silver; it also lay on the Ohio River, along which Mexican gold and silver could be shipped by steamboat to or from a port city like New Orleans in just five days. For a broker hoping to transfer gold and silver between western banks and the rest of the world, Louisville may have been an ideal location.

In South America and again in Mexico, Francis Drexel had dealt sporadically in foreign money and had developed relationships with important government figures. When Francis launched his new career in 1837, Spanish money and bills of exchange on Germany and Ireland were in great demand. Presumably Francis expected to capitalize on his foreign contacts and his linguistic fluency in both German and Spanish. Instead, once in business he appears again to have adapted his skills to the need of the moment: to track down foreign gold and silver for redemption of the accumulated notes of state banks in the U.S. hinterlands. Within two years Francis would bring his son Anthony, then just thirteen years old, into the currency business; thirty-two years after that, Anthony would beckon Pierpont Morgan to his monumental mission in life. He was the type guy to have underkarated the gold!

As of the info that follows, Anthony Joseph Drexel had of course taken over the reins of the Drexel finance enterprises, his father Francis Drexel having been taken by the Reaper in 1863---





It wasn't until 1871 that the original J.P. Morgan (1837-1913, Pilgrims Society V.P.) affiliated with Anthony Joseph Drexel (1826-1893), son of Francis Martin Drexel. Morgan's father Junius Spencer Morgan (1813-1890, died of injuries in a carriage accident) in 1854 entered George Peabody & Company of London as a partner in the banking firm; Peabody viewed him as his adopted son. In 1864 George Peabody (1795-1869 had "an extravagant fortune") retired and the firm's name changed to J.S. Morgan & Company. Peabody and Junius Morgan financed American railroads, other large interests and dealt in War Bonds for the North. Peabody was a well established operator when in 1845 he paid bribes to Daniel Webster! When Junius S. Morgan died in 1890, Anthony J. Drexel was a pallbearer, along with Levi Parsons Morton, a big time CROOK who was a charter Pilgrims member in NYC in 1903. Morton (1824-1920) was Ambassador to France and Governor of New York and married into the fantastic Livingston dynasty. Other pallbearers were Chauncey Depew, a Vanderbilt attorney (also a charter Pilgrims member in 1903) and Cornelius Vanderbilt II, who wasn't a Pilgrims member as he died in 1899.




J. P. Morgan & Co. in New York, and Drexel & Co. in Philadelphia, as at present: also head of the London banking house of J. S. Morgan & Co., and the Paris house of Morgan, Harjes & Co. Has many times rendered valuable service to the United States Government since the Civil War, notably in flotation of Government bonds in 1876, 1877 and 1878, and also 1895, when his firm floated the \$62,000,000 gold bonds issued by the Cleveland administration to restore the normal Treasury surplus of \$100,000,000 and thereby saved the Treasury from a silver basis; Of J.P. Morgan Sr. we read on page 290 of "The Morgans: <u>Private</u> International Bankers 1854-1913 (Harvard University Press 1987) ---

He considered the campaign for free silver and bimetalism serious threats to the nation's credit and business, requiring the united opposition of all "sound" individuals. Early in February 1891 he assured Henry Lee Higginson that "all our advices are to the effect that for the present Session there is no danger of any action on free coinage."

Page <u>695</u> mentions the Specie Payment Act of 1875 Providing for redemption of greenbacks in gold as Of 1879 was denounced by "debtors, farmers and Silver mining interests" (because of silver's Exclusion, which the Constitution included As lawful money!)




Read on; you will soon see that Anthony J. Drexel, Morgan's mentor, disdained Monetary silver!



Page 638, J.P. Morgan Sr. was Episcopalian and had Huguenot ancestry "Who's <u>Who</u> in Finance, Banking & Insurance" (1911).

He descended from Miles Morgan who arrived from England in Boston back in 1636! Huguenots are French Protestants who had terrific clashes with Catholics in France in the early 1570s; Huguenot survivors fled France. Note that Morgan Sr.'s mentor Anthony Drexel had as his daddy a man who was raised Catholic! 

In 1884 Grant died in a cottage in upstate New York owned by Tony's younger brother Joseph and Tony served as a pallbearer at his funeral. University Archives has in its possession a letter Grant wrote to Tony in 1878 during his post-presidency trip around the world. Tony turned down a position as Secretary of Treasury in President Ulysses S. Grant's presidential cabinet, but he continued to advise Grant on financial affairs when he was president. Tony also personally managed Grants' finances for years."

"Soon after his father's death in 1863, Anthony Drexel purchased a large plot of land centered at the intersection of 39th and Walnut streets, far out in West Philadelphia. He then commissioned an unknown architect (possibly Samuel Sloan, designer of nearby Woodland Terrace) to design a sprawling Italianate villa, where he, his wife Ellen, and their nine children could live away from the noise and dirt of Center City. He was also generous to his extended family, frequently looking after his niece Katharine Drexel, whose father Francis Jr. raised his children as strict Roman Catholics. His brother **Anthony however crossed the Reformation aisle, raising his family as Episcopalians.** As an adult, Katharine renounced her privileged upbringing altogether and became a nun, donating her time and vast inheritance to Native American and African-American civil rights causes."

Anthony Joseph Drexel (1826-1893) realized that to rise higher in the financial cosmos, remaining Roman Catholic would not get him there! He became Episcopalian, the name the Protestant Anglican Church of England goes by in America. He knew the Royal family (runs Church of England) solidly OUTRANKED the Pope of Rome in world power! It's quite possible his connections to Peabody and Morgan in London accomplished this religious conversion driven by ambition!

In <u>1858</u> at age 21, John Pierpont Morgan (the original J.P. Morgan) began handling the New York business office of

George Peabody & Company, with his father Junius Spencer Morgan remaining at the head office in London. In <u>1871</u> the firm of Drexel, Morgan & Company started operations with Anthony Joseph Drexel as senior partner and his mentor, same as George Peabody acted as mentor to Junius Morgan! In 1893 Anthony Drexel passed away, and by 1895 Drexel, Morgan & Company was renamed J.P. Morgan & Company, similar to how George Peabody & Company was earlier renamed J.S. Morgan & Company 31 years before.

Anthony Joseph Drexel was no mere pencil pusher as we are about to see. We still need more flashback and supplemental info on his father Francis Martin Drexel and also on his brothers and sisters. F.M. Drexel married Catherine Hookey (1795-1870) at Holy Trinity Roman Catholic Church in Philadelphia on April 23, 1821. Their daughter Mary (1822-1873) married but left no survivors. Another child, Heloise Drexel Smith (1837-1895) appeared to have left no survivors. A son, Francis Anthony Drexel (1824-1885) also in finance, was married twice; to Hannah J. Langstroth with whom he fathered two children, Elizabeth (deceased 1890) and Catherine Mary Drexel (1858-1955) who became a Roman Catholic nun and was appointed to Catholic sainthood by the Pope in AD 2000. Second marriage of Francis Anthony Drexel was to Emma Bouvier, daughter of wealthy land speculator Michel Bouvier. Bouvier was the paternal great, great grandfather of Jacqueline Bouvier

Kennedy Onassis (JFK's widow!) Another Drexel sibling was Joseph William Drexel (1833-1888) who married Lucy Wharton (1841-1912). J.W. Drexel also in finance at Drexel & Company (where his brother Anthony was senior partner) was a trustee of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in NYC, the NYC Metropolitan Opera and the United States National Academy of Sciences. Another daughter of F.M. Drexel, Catherine (1838-1911) married investment banker John Goddard Watmough. F.A. Drexel's estate was reported as \$15.5 million, undoubtedly an extreme lowball.

His daughter Catherine Mary Drexel became a Roman Catholic nun---this situation may have delayed/hindered the Drexels from eventual Pilgrims membership, as the English Royals and the Pope of Rome have been in conflict at least since the <u>assassination</u> way back in AD 1170 of the Archbishop of Canterbury, Thomas Becket, by knights of King Henry II, who was disenchanted with Pope Alexander III and vice versa. Finally in AD 1534, disgusted with foreign based religious meddling in his kingdom, King Henry VIII founded the Anglican Church of England and instituted it as "the" church of the land. It remains so till this very moment, and there is a perpetual ban against any Roman Catholic ever sitting on the throne of England---





Mother Drexel's canonization by Pope John Paul in October 2000 was the occasion for some 200 Drexel family members—Catholics, Protestants, and nonbelievers alike—to fly to Rome for the ceremony.

Catholic baiters will seize on this to say "see, the Pope runs the world and bosses the Drexels," well he probably bosses some Drexels, the secondary lines at best, but the main family line has long since been loyal to the Royal family of England---Protestant Anglicans, known here as Episcopalians.

Joseph William Drexel (1833-1888) and his wife Lucy were parents of Katherine Drexel (1866-1918) who married Dr. Charles B. 



The prestige associated with the Drexel name at the time of A. J. At one time or another Drexels were related to Vanderbilts, Dukes, Roosevelts (both the Theodore and FDR branches), Bouviers, Biddles, Whartons, Wyeths, Whitneys, Mellons, Astors, Ingersolls, Cassatts, Cadwaladers, and Goulds, as well as the British nobility. By the end of the twentieth century only five American universities—Drexel, Vanderbilt, Duke, Brown, and Rutgers—were still linked to their founding families; all five families were related to the Drexels.





But his profession would not provide a living for his young son, Anthony Jr. So that year, according to *The New York Times* later, he "determined to engage in business as a broker in order to open up a career for his son." On New Year's Day 1838 he opened his small brokerage office "in which were laid the foundations of the enormous business" that would be eventually run by his son. Three years later the younger Anthony entered the business at the age of 13. He took on his father's ambitious and aggressive business nature. By the time of the California Gold Rush in 1848 Anthony Drexel Sr. left his son in charge of the firm while he traveled, often for extended periods."


"In 1850 the senior Drexel took advantage of the Gold Rush and established the firm of Drexel, Sather & Church in California. Simultaneously he opened a New York City house, Drexel & Co. Before long what had started out as a one-man operation was a leading force in American banking. "The house's business was always that of money lending on a gigantic scale," noted The New York Times in 1893, "and its timely help saved many a suffering corporation from bankruptcy, while it piled up the millions to its own credit, and strengthened year by year the already strong foundation of its tremendous trade." In 1869 Anthony Drexel, Jr. partnered with J. Pierpont Morgan whom he entrusted to run the New York branch which was renamed Drexel, Morgan & Co. In 1872 the powerful banking firm laid plans for a headquarters building that would turn heads. On March paid \$250,000 (over \$4.5 million today) in gold for the land at the southeast corner of Wall and Broad Streets. The *Times* reported on March 17, 1872 that "more money was paid for it than any other piece of ground of a similar area of which there is any record in any city in the world."

"Drexel, Morgan & Co. commissioned architect Arthur D. Gilman to design the structure which *The Times* predicted would be "magnificent." Work commenced on May 1, 1872 with an anticipated completion of April 1, 1873. The six-story building would be clad in gleaming white Vermont marble and while Gilman described the style as "Italian renaissance" it would be deemed French Second Empire today. There would be a grand mansard roof above the fifth floor cornice, crowned by a faceted cap at the corner. On either side dormers would line up with military precision. As the Drexel Building neared completion in April 1873 advertisements for office space appeared. Offices for "Corporations, Bankers, Lawyers &c." were offered and the structure's up-to-date accommodations were marketed. "Two elevators, two staircases, fire-proof, well ventilated and lighted, heated by steam; every modern convenience on each floor."

"The advertisements did not touch on the upscale finishes and amenities. *The New York Times* remarked that the building was "finely finished throughout with black walnut and mahogany, marble floors, &c," and said that the grand staircase was "one of the largest in New-York." Above the main entrance were two larger-than-life statues representing Europe and America. Drexel Morgan

& Co. took nearly half of the ground floor and the remainder of the building filled quickly. a surprising number of railroad concerns moved in. Within the first few years the building became home to the Missouri Pacific Railroad offices, the New-Jersey and New-York Railroad Company, the Hackensack and New York Railroad Company, the New-York City and Northern Railway Company, and the Hackensack and New-York Extension Railroad offices. On September 4, 1882 the attention of the world was centered on the Drexel Building as inventor Thomas Alva Edison flipped a switch, illuminating 600 electric lights throughout the building. It was a ground-breaking moment that would jump-start the transition from gas to incandescent lighting."

By June 1914 the Drexel Building was demolished and the new J.P. Morgan & Company Building was completed on the site---

Rozet seems to have something to do with "rose" as in flower. Some records spell it Roset; the Drexels spell it Rozet so that's the correct form.

Continuing the review of the children of Anthony and Ellen Drexel we find Mae E. Drexel (1857-1886) married Charles T. Stewart. Sarah Rozet Drexel (1860-1929) married John R. 



John R Drexel II was a member of the Drexel family who loved flying (and crashing) planes. He was the extremely irresponsible son of John R Sr and Alice Troth. He grew up a life of extreme excess and spent his summers in Newport.

He married Elizabeth Thompson and they had a son, John R Drexel III, also known as Johnny, in 1919. It was that year that his father bought him his first plane, valued at \$5,000. Soon after his first flight in the plane, John crashed it into a river. No matter, his father bought him another, this one valued at \$9,000. 2 months later, John rammed the plane into the boathouse of his family's Philadelphia estate. The next two planes he crashed onto the driveway of his Long Island estate. The fifth he slammed into the side of his Newport home, Cliff Walk. The sixth and seventh both were banged into his neighbor's houses in Philadelphia. The eighth had a faulty propeller and it snapped while he was in mid-air, which resulted in him crashing it into his wife's flower garden at their home in Philadelphia. His ninth and final plane he rammed into the ground in a valley outside of Paris, where he was visiting his mother. This resulted in him being paralyzed from the waist down.

He died in 1957, with more than \$50 million in his will. John had never really done anything in his life, and so his main source of income was the interest from his inheritance.




He gave the Drexel family its first representation (Maternally) in The Pilgrims USA by 1957; he May have been a member by 1955---





In connection with Anthony J. **"Angier Biddle Duke** (November 30, 1915 – April 29, 1995) was an American soldier, diplomat in the United States Foreign Service and a White House aide. In 1952, at age 36, he became the youngest American ambassador in history when he was appointed to be the U.S. Ambassador to El Salvador. Duke was born in New York City. His father was Angier Buchanan Duke (1884–1923) and his mother was Cordelia Drexel Biddle, later Cordelia Biddle Robertson. Angier Buchanan Duke was an heir to the American Tobacco Company fortune while Cordelia Drexel Biddle was a member of the Biddle family who were prominent in business, political and cultural affairs in Philadelphia. Angier Biddle Duke's only sibling was Anthony Drexel Duke (1918–2014). After separating in 1918, Duke's parents divorced in 1921. His paternal grandfather was Benjamin Newton Duke (1855–1929), a major benefactor of Duke University and brother of James Buchanan Duke, himself the father of Doris Duke, Angier's cousin. His maternal grandfather was Anthony Joseph Drexel Biddle, Sr. Through his mother he was a great-great-grandson of banker Anthony Joseph Drexel. Duke attended St. Paul's School in Concord New Hampshire. He dropped out of Yale University in 1936."

(St. Paul's School is Episcopalian; current tuition \$60,000).

"In 1979, the administration brought him back again to serve as the U.S. Ambassador to Morocco, a position he held until 1981 when he was succeeded by Joseph Verner Reed, Jr. following Ronald Reagan's election to President. From 1992 to 1995, Duke served as the elected president of the Council of American Ambassadors. In 1936, he married Priscilla Avenal St. George (1919–1995). She was the daughter of George Baker Bligh St. George and Katharine St. George, a member of the U.S. House of Representatives from New York. Her maternal grandmother, Catherine Delano Collier, was the younger sister of Sara Delano Roosevelt, the mother of President Franklin Delano Roosevelt and her great-grandfather was **George Fisher Baker**, the financier and philanthropist. Her father was the grandson of Robert St George, himself the son of Sir Richard Bligh St George, 2nd Baronet Before their divorce in August 1940, they were the parents of:

"Angier "Pony" St. George Duke (1937–2014), who married Mary Ellen Haga in 1973. He was known for infecting Margaret Housen with gonorrhea in 1970."

(Note that George Fisher Baker was an original Pilgrims member in NYC in 1903 while J.P. Morgan Senior was not until 1910! And that Baker was personally much wealthier than Morgan and more influential in the railroad industry!)

"Following their divorce, Priscilla married State Senator Allan A. Ryan, Jr. (1903–1981) in 1941. In November 1940, the 26 year old Duke married the 34 year old Margaret Screven White immediately after her divorce from J. M. Tuck. Margaret had also been married to Fitzhugh White and was the daughter of Franklin Buchanan Screven, great-granddaughter of Admiral Franklin Screven, commander of the Confederate USS *Merrimack*, and a descendant of Thomas McKean, a signer of the Declaration of Independence." "They divorced in 1952; the same year Duke married Maria-Luisa de Arana of Spain. She was the daughter of Isabella de Zurita and Dario de Arana and the granddaughter of the 10th Marquis de Campo Real, members of the Basque nobility of Bilbao. His third wife died in a plane crash in 1961."

"In 1962, he married Robin Chandler Lynn (1923–2016), who served as the United States Ambassador to Norway during the Clinton administration. She had previously been married to Jeffrey Lynn, the actor and film producer, and was the daughter of Richard Edgar and Esther Chandler Tippett. They lived together at 740 Park Avenue in New York. Robin and Angier remained married until his death in 1995. Angier Biddle Duke, Jr. (b. 1963). Duke died at age 79 from being struck by a car while rollerblading."







Duke was a board member, trustee and chair of numerous corporate, foundation and organization boards, including the U.N. Mrs. John R. Drexel III (Hon. M. S. Noreen Stonor), 90, of Newport and Palm Beach died unexpectedly in Newport on November 6, 2012, after suffering a stroke.

Born the Honorable Mildred Sophia Noreen Stonor in Henley-on-Thames, England, in 1922, Mrs. Drexel was the youngest child of Ralph Francis Julian Stonor, 5th Baron Camoys, and the former Mildred Constance Sherman, of Stonor Park, England. Stonor Park has been in the family since the 11th century.

### We'll have a look at Number Five Baron Camoys and his grandson Number Seven Baron Camoys, who became a member of The Pilgrims of Great Britain back in 1978!

Mrs. Drexel came to Newport as a teenager on the eve of the Second World War with her mother, the daughter of William Watts Sherman, a prominent New York businessman and treasurer of the Newport Casino. On her American side, she was a descendant of Roger Williams, founder of Providence Plantations (renamed Rhode Island), and of Nicholas Brown, a Providence merchant and co-founder of what was to become Brown University. Her English ancestors were Roman Catholics who became Recusants when Henry VIII attempted to abolish the Catholic Church in England. Members of her family were severely punished for refusing to renounce their religion. As a result, Mrs. Drexel's family tree includes eight Roman Catholic saints.

W.W. <u>Sherman</u> was a member of the Saint Nicholas Society of New York, which very much is still in operation, and represents heritage of old-line Dutch Colonial wealth in New Amsterdam (renamed New York in 1664). That society is well interlocked with The Pilgrims. Sherman may have been related to the Treasury Secretary John Sherman and General William T. Sherman (haven't checked it out). W.W. Sherman was a partner in Duncan, Sherman & Company, what today we'd call a "boutique private investment bank" but the lead partner was William Butler Duncan who was president of The Pilgrims New York (1907-1912). Guess what! J.P. Morgan Senior was with Duncan. Sherman & Company for a time starting in 1857; the year of a financial panic! Duncan was chairman of the important Mobile & Ohio Railroad which eventually had 1,536 miles of railroad track. Roger Williams (1603-1683) as they noted founded what became Rhode Island. Nicholas Brown (1729-1791) held interests in an iron foundry, a distillery, tobacco and made a slave trading foray. A member of this same Brown family, Thatcher M. Brown III (Pilgrims 2014 and earlier lists) is at Brown Brothers Harriman (represents \$4.2 TRILLION). The Brown lineage intersected with Bayards, Mellons, Vanderbilts, Goelets; no surprise. John Nicholas Brown II (1900-1979) was a member of The Pilgrims. His son John Carter Brown III (Pilgrims 1986) married Constance Mellon Byers; the same Pilgrims Society family as in the name of Bank of New York Mellon (represents \$32 TRILLION; and NO ROTHSCHILDS!). J.C. Brown III's second wife was Pamela Braga Drexel---who---guess what---was the first wife of Pilgrims Society member John R. Drexel IV, since married to Jacqueline Astor! Braga is old Portuguese nobility! Finally from the

preceding scan we note that the ancestors of Noreen Stonor Drexel remained Catholic after King Henry VIII of England founded his Protestant Anglican Church of England in AD 1534, and took heat because of it. Mrs. Drexel was born into circumstances that did not require her to do anything with her life, but do so she did. Early in her life she became chair of Bundles for Britain and headed the Newport War Bond Drive. She volunteered at the Newport Naval Hospital, where she had many jobs. Working in the motor pool as an ambulance driver, she was often on the scene of fires, hurricanes and other disasters. Her tenure at the Naval Hospital continued through the Second World War, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War.

For a time, Mrs. Drexel lived in Palm Beach, where she ran the American Red Cross office. 



In Newport, Mrs. Drexel was a trustee and chair of the Alletta Morris McBean Charitable Trust. Under her leadership, the Trust has supported the Newport Hospital, Salve Regina University, churches, the Touro Synagogue, the City of Newport, social service organizations, schools, libraries, and many other charitable organizations. The recurrent themes of her lifetime of work have been health care and education. The Noreen Stonor Drexel Birthing Center at Newport Hospital welcomes children to a city that Mrs. Drexel has done so much to improve. In recognition of her service to the City-by-the-Sea and many others, she was awarded the degree of Honorary Doctor of Humane Letters in 1989 by Salve Regina, on whose board of trustees she served for many years.



Drexel III's wife was associated with this Catholic university; yet he was Episcopalian, and her funeral service was Episcopalian. Seems to be a case of keeping one foot in both major camps! Drexel IV of Millerton, NY, and Mrs. William J. O'Farrell Jr. (E. M. Noreen Drexel) of Jamestown, RI; seven grandsons; two great-granddaughters; and one great-grandson.

Following her funeral in Newport, Mrs. Drexel was flown to England, where she was buried near her mother and other relatives in the churchyard at Pishill Church on a hill overlooking Stonor Park, where she had lived until she came to the United States. 



Alice Gordon Troth (1866-1947) married John R. Drexel Sr. (1863-1935), the eldest son of Anthony J. Drexel (1826-1893) and Ellen Rozet (1832-1891). Alice and John Sr. had four children, but the oldest daughter died at a young age. Their eldest son John R. Drexel Jr. "Jack" (1890-1936) married Elizabeth Thompson (1896-1943), and had only one child, John R. Drexel III "Sonny" (1919-2007).

Alice Gordon Troth, born in 1865, was the daughter of William Penn Troth and the former Clara Sharpless Townsend of Philadelphia. Alice and John lived in Philadelphia, New York, and Rhode Island. In 1921, Alice and John left New York for Paris. Alice was close to her grandson John R. Drexel III who spent summers with her in France. When she died in 1947, she left her entire estate to her grandson.


The Pilgrims are a Royalist, not a Papal, sponsored group. The Royals of England and the Papacy were in conflict long before King Henry VIII started the Anglican Church of England in AD 1534. On December 29, 1170, Thomas Becket who was (Catholic) Archbishop of Canterbury was <u>hacked</u> into pieces by knights representing King Henry II of England. "Clement died in September 1534 and was succeeded by Paul III, and Paul used his power of excommunication against Henry, followed by his rescinding Henry's title as "Defender of the Faith." England's parliament declared that title still valid. Pope Paul had to watch – powerless – as Henry "nationalized" all Roman Church property in England into his personal ownership and sold off these properties to the highest bidders among the aristocracy and the gentry. Roman priests in England were dismissed unless they swore an oath of conformity to Henry's new Church. Those who would not were dispossessed of their positions and livelihood, or if they made too much political noise they executed as "recusants" – dissidents." Henry executed various Catholics." Not all "recusant" Catholics were done away with; the Stonor family being a prime example. The Cecil family became very high advisers to English monarchy and ran a sort of "Secret Service" or "CIA" and had various Catholics tortured occasionally in the Tower of London. 

Muir, Master of the British Empire, was publisher of Newsweek. He was <u>Episcopalian</u>.

Pyne of Citibank inherited several huge 1800s fortunes in banking, railroads and public utilities. 

As of 1968 Gardner remained a consultant to CCNY; during 1955 to 1965 he was its president and during the same years he was simultaneously president of the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching (globalism). Gardner chaired the Urban Coalition (1968-1970, elitists managing commoners in metro areas); he became chairman of Common Cause in 1970, a front used by elitists to hoodwink the simpleminded into supporting their own loss of rights.



In 1961 Gardner authored "Excellence" asking the question on the back cover, "Can we be equal and excellent too" this was a eugenics thrust! In 1960 he was on JFK's Task Force on Education; in 1959 to 1962 he was a "social sciences adviser" (eugenics again) to the National Science Foundation. In 1964 Gardner chaired President Johnson's Task Force on Education and chaired the White House Conference on Education in 1965. He became a trustee of Stanford University in 1968 and later a Rockefeller Brothers Fund trustee. He was in the quirky elitist Bohemian Club in San Francisco and was a director of the prestigious American Academy of Arts and Sciences ("Who's Who in America," 1974, page 1099). Ahh yes, in 1965 to 1968 Gardner was Secretary of Health Education and Welfare Department.



Thomas Sovereign Gates (born 1906; Pilgrims executive committee by 1972) became associated in 1928 with Drexel & Company Philadelphia. During 1940 to 1953 Gates was a <u>partner</u> in Drexel & Company. From there he vaulted upwards into the post of undersecretary of the U.S. Navy (1953-1957); he became Secretary of the Navy (1957-1959) and Secretary of Defense 1959 to 1960. In 1961 to 1965 Gates was president of Morgan Guaranty Trust and chairman 1965 to 1970. Gates was a member of Rockefeller University Council and a trustee of the (Episcopalian) Foxcroft Academy and the University of Pennsylvania. Gates was adviser to School of Advanced International Studies at Johns Hopkins University and the National War College. Gates was on such boards as Cities Service Company; General Electric; Scott Paper; Bethlehem Steel; Smith Kline & French Labs (pharma); Insurance Company of North America; Campbell Soup et cetera ("Who's Who in America" 1974 page 1108). He was a member of the Economic Club of New York, very opposed to monetary use of silver and a director of the Academy of Political Science. Notice major steel interests allegedly competitors---Republic and Bethlehem Steel---both Pilgrims Society represented. Gates---



John M. Meyer Jr. was president of Morgan Guaranty Trust (subsidiary of J.P. 

FEBRUARY 17, 2017 Home to an immense diversity of marine life, the deep ocean also contains valuable minerals with metals such as nickel, copper, cobalt, manganese, zinc, and gold, and rareearth elements used in electronic technology like smart phones and medical imaging machines. As demand for these resources increases and supplies on land decrease, commercial mining operators are looking to the deep ocean as the next frontier for mining.

Currently, there's no mining occurring in the ocean deeper than the continental shelves, but the industry is moving forward quickly. Many of the engineering challenges associated with working in the deep sea have already been addressed by the offshore oil and gas industry. Different types of machines for mining have been built and the components for mining systems are currently being tested in deep-sea deployments.

About 27 countries have already signed contracts to explore for deep-sea resources with the International Seabed Authority (ISA), the organization that controls mineral exploration and exploitation in the area beyond national jurisdiction. And the first deep-sea mining project —Solwara 1 within the jurisdiction of Papua New Guinea—is scheduled to begin in 2019 by Nautilus Minerals.

# Why Do They Matter?

Hydrothermal vents act as natural plumbing systems that transport heat and chemicals from the interior of the Earth and that help regulate global ocean chemistry. In the process, they accumulate vast amounts of potentially valuable minerals on the seafloor.

The mammoth copper mines of Cyprus, for example, were formed by hydrothermal activity millions of years ago before those rocks were uplifted from the seafloor to become dry land. Commercially valuable mineral deposits are believed to exist on the seafloor near hydrothermal vents, and a few companies have had plans in development for years to exploit some of these. The difficulty of mining in deep water near fragile ecosystems and the relatively small size of ocean bottom deposits compared to those on land have so far prevented seafloor mining from becoming commercially viable.

# What is Seafloor Mining?

The ocean contains a complex combination of physical, chemical, biological, and geological processes that sometimes result in commercially viable forms of a wide range of minerals. This is particularly true in the deep ocean at areas around hydrothermal vents where hot, chemical-rich fluids pouring up from beneath the seafloor produce potentially valuable deposits. A few efforts to mine deposits on the seafloor have succeeded, but to date, not many have overcome the technical challenges involved in retrieving large amounts of material from the deep ocean.

Some successful mining has already occurred in relatively shallow waters less than 200 meters. In the 1960s, Marine Diamond Corp. recovered nearly 1 million carats from the coast of Namibia. Today, de Beers obtains a significant portion of its total diamond production from the continental shelf of southern Africa. Mining operations in deeper waters have led to a very different results: When investors tried about 40 years ago to retrieve potato-sized manganese nodules scattered on the ocean floor, almost half a billion dollars worth of prospecting couldn't make their efforts profitable.

Since then, the mining industry has been hard at work developing specialized dredgers, pumps, crawlers, drills, platforms, cutters and corers, many of them robotic and all designed to work in the harsh conditions of the deep ocean. In addition, increases in the price of many materials such as copper, plus increasing demand from emerging economies is making such ventures more economically feasible. Recent discoveries of rich deposits on the seafloor and advances in technology are generating renewed interest in seafloor mining, including more diamonds, iron sands, cobalt-rich manganese crusts, phosphorite nodules and even those problematic manganese nodules. The rising importance and increasing scarcity of rare earth elements is also making some take a new look at the possibility of refining these materials from seafloor sources.

Most attractive of all for the mining industry are the potential riches at deep-sea hydrothermal vents. Known for nourishing lush communities of exotic life, the vents also can be treasure troves of high-grade minerals. When the very hot, chemical-rich fluids that spout or seep from the vents meet the cold water of the ocean, dissolved minerals solidify from the fluids and billow into the water or fall onto the seafloor or build up into massive chimney-like structures. These chimneys appear to billow black or white "smoke" depending on the chemical makeup of the fluids. Many sulfide deposits on land likely were formed the same way and were later were raised above sea level during the formation of islands and continents over millions of years. The island of Cyprus, for example, holds 30 massive sulfide deposits, which were a main source of copper for ancient Rome.

For a number of reasons, the mining industry's interest in seafloor massive sulfides is focusing mostly on vent fields in the western South Pacific. Many of the vent fields are located within the exclusive economic zones of small island nations, eliminating the potential complications of mining the seabed that lies under international waters. Many hundreds of thousands of square kilometers of the region's seafloor have been leased for exploration and mining could begin as early as 2019 off the coast of Papua New Guinea.

## Why is it important?

Seafloor mining has the potential to help meet demand for many minerals used worldwide and could help bolster the economies of developing nations in one of two ways. The mining could take place in a nation's own exclusive economic zone, or it could take place on the seafloor under international waters, where the International Seabed Authority dictates that a portion of all mining profits benefit developing nations.

# Where the minerals are

The metals lie in what are called seafloor massive sulfide deposits. They form as the result of a series of chemical reactions that start when seawater filters down through permeable ocean crust into rocks heated by magma below. The heat catalyzes reactions that leach metals from the rocks into the fluids. The hot fluids—which can reach up to 750°F (400°C) under the pressure in the deep—rise buoyantly back to the seafloor. As they emerge from the crust, they encounter cold water, which causes metal sulfides to precipitate out of the fluids and form solid deposits near and on the seafloor.

The ocean's known sulfide deposits may be only a fraction of what's actually there. "There's a lot of real estate out there where no data have been collected," said WHOI geochemist Chris German.

The "Precious Metals from Deep-Sea Vents" workshop and colloquium was funded by the Elisabeth W. and Henry A. Morss, Jr., Colloquia Endowed Fund at WHOI, the ChEss (Chemosynthetic Ecosystem) project of the Census of Marine Life, InterRidge, Ridge 2000, and the WHOI Deep Ocean Exploration Institute.

The Order of St John,<sup>[3]</sup> formally the Most Venerable Order of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem (French: l'ordre très vénérable de l'Hôpital de Saint-Jean de Jérusalem<sup>[n 1]</sup>) and also known as St John International,<sup>[4]</sup> is a British royal order of chivalry first constituted in 1888 by royal charter from Queen Victoria.

The Order traces its origins back to the Knights Hospitaller in the Middle Ages, which was later known as the Order of Malta. A faction of them emerged in France in the 1820s and moved to Britain in the early 1830s, where, after operating under a succession of grand priors and different names, it became associated with the founding in 1882 of the St John Ophthalmic Hospital near the old city of Jerusalem and the St John Ambulance Brigade in 1887.


The order is found throughout the Commonwealth of Nations,<sup>[5]</sup> Hong Kong, the Republic of Ireland, and the United States of America,<sup>[6]</sup> with the worldwide mission "to prevent and relieve sickness and injury, and to act to enhance the health and well-being of people anywhere in the world."<sup>(6)</sup> The order's approximately 25,000 members, known as confrères,<sup>[5]</sup> are mostly of the Protestant faith, though those of other Christian denominations or other religions are accepted into the order. Except via appointment to certain government or ecclesiastical offices in some realms, membership is by invitation only and individuals may not petition for admission.

The Order of St John is perhaps best known for the health organisations it founded and continues to run, including St John Ambulance and St John Eye Hospital Group. As with the Order, the memberships and work of these organizations are not constricted by denomination or religion. The Order is a constituent member of the Alliance of the Orders of Saint John of Jerusalem. Its headquarters are in London and it is a registered charity under English law.<sup>[7]</sup>



They're a secretive religious order with a long and bloody history and unique status under international law, but that doesn't mean they run the world.


"The Sovereign Military Hospitaller Order of Saint John of Jerusalem of Rhodes and of Malta is a Roman Catholic organization based in Rome with around 13,000 members worldwide. The group was founded in 1048 by Amalfian merchants in Jerusalem as a monastic order that ran a hospital to tend to Christian pilgrims in the Holy Land. At the height of its power, the order was also tasked by Rome with the additional military function of defending Christians from the local Muslim population. The Knights of St. John were just one of a number of Christian military orders founded during this period — including the fabled but now defunct Knights of Templar. When the Sultan of Egypt retook Jerusalem in 1291, the Knights of St. John went into exile, settling in Rhodes 20 years later. In 1523 they were forced from Rhodes by the Sultan's forces and settled in Malta, which they ruled until they were dislodged by Napoleon's army in 1798. The order settled in Rome in the mid-19th century, where it remains to this day."

"Despite its name, the Knights haven't had any military function since leaving Malta. Instead, the order has gone back to its charitable roots by sponsoring medical missions in more than 120 countries. When the order was founded, knights were expected to take a vow of poverty, chastity, and obedience upon joining. Nowadays, obedience is enough. Membership is still by invitation only, but you no longer have to be a member of the nobility. In recent years, the organization has become increasingly American in membership. The leader of the order, referred to as the prince and grand master, is elected for life in a secret conclave and must be approved by the pope." "Despite having no fixed territory besides its headquarters building in Rome, the order is considered a sovereign entity under international law. It prints its own postage stamps and coins — though these are mostly for novelty value — and enjoys observer status at the United Nations, which classifies it as a nonstate entity like the Red Cross. The Knights maintain diplomatic relations with 104 countries. The order does not have official relations with the United States, though it has offices in New York, for the United Nations delegation, and Washington, for its representation at the Inter-American Development Bank. Because of its secretive proceedings, unique political status, and association with the Crusades, the order has been a popular target for conspiracy theorists."

The Order of Saint John of Jerusalem, organized in 1888 by Royal charter of Queen Victoria, states they <u>welcome</u> people of any faith into their ranks; regardless, it's overwhelmingly Anglican in the United Kingdom and pervasively Episcopalian in America. J. Peter Grace (Pilgrims 1969 and other years) of Citibank, Kennecott Copper, Ingersoll Rand, Stone & Webster, Brascan and various other major corporations, was a member of the founding board of the Catholic Knights of Malta in America ("Who's Who in America," 1978, page 1262). Grace was publicly Catholic, and underground as a member of the Royalist Pilgrims Society. 



"In 1940, several former Drexel partners and associates formed an investment bank and assumed the rights to the "Drexel and Company" name. The old Drexel, which chose to concentrate on commercial banking after the Glass–Steagall Act regulated the separation of commercial and investment banking, was completely absorbed into the Morgan Empire. The new Drexel grew slowly, coasting on its predecessor's historic ties to the larger securities issuers. It merged with Harriman, Ripley and Company in 1965 and renamed itself Drexel Harriman Ripley. In the mid-1970s, it sold a 25 percent stake to Firestone Tire and Rubber Company, renaming itself Drexel Firestone."

The "Morgan Empire" is not primarily the Morgan family and its marriage linkages to other families like the Pennoyers and Hamiltons, but to the totality of Pilgrims Society dynasties back of J.P. Morgan & Company, and today's JPM Chase Bank. As of 1970, A. Brooks Firestone became a member of The Pilgrims Society London. The 2014 roster shows him still a member---


The Harrimans had a solid history of membership in The Pilgrims. Joseph P. Ripley appeared in The Pilgrims NYC 1969. As to the "several former Drexel partners," I wouldn't figure they left without any continuing linkage to the great Drexel dynasty. More from Wiki---

"Even though Burnham was the senior partner in the merger, the more powerful investment banks (whose informal blessing the new firm needed to survive on Wall Street) insisted that the Drexel name come first as a condition of joining the "major" bracket. Thus, Drexel Burnham and Company, headquartered in New York, was born in 1973 with \$44 million in capital. In 1976, it merged with William D. Witter, a "research boutique" that was the American arm of Belgian-based Groupe Bruxelles Lambert. The firm was renamed Drexel Burnham Lambert, and incorporated that year after 41 years as a limited partnership. The enlarged firm was privately held; Lambert held a 26 percent stake and received six seats on the board of directors."

Dean Witter Jr. (Pilgrims NYC 1974) and William F. Witter were related. Dean Witter Reynolds was capitalized over 17 times more than Drexel Burnham (\$17.3 billion) and had Pilgrims Society member Richard S. Reynolds Jr. of the aluminum fortune behind it. In <u>1978</u> it merged into silver suppressor Morgan Stanley.

New York Magazine, <u>March</u> 1990 page 35 reported Drexel Burnham Lambert sold over \$100 billion in junk bonds during 1977-1989. Page 37 mentioned that it was Mellon Bank withholding a line of credit in a Drexel Burnham Lambert deal that lit the torch to send the firm down the tubes. The Mellon dynasty, very likely wealthier than even the combined Astor-Drexel dynasties, is of course Pilgrims Society represented. The combusting of Drexel Burnham Lambert and the hard fall of Mike Milken, the junk bond mogul, very likely didn't cost the actual Drexel family a nickel.

On November 26, 2012, Ted Butler stated that as of 1983, the lead silver short was Drexel Burnham Lambert. Astor Jr. was with Bache & Company, that sold the Hunts and their silver play down the river.

It has strong ties to The Concorde Group and Blackhawk Capital Group. Management has background with Merrill Lynch, Morgan Stanley and Bankers Trust. Their HQ is at 17 State Street NYC. Its connections with the Drexel family are uncertain or TBD.



I was in on a private placement with major SSRI in 2001, without any newsletter subscription! If you've a local metals dealer, do business there to help him stay in business as it could become more RISKY to ship PM's! At least stay with top rated dealers like CMI in Phoenix.

It isn't cool to be a free public service information provider when all the interviewers and guests are there to siphon money from their bamboozled audiences mesmerized by misplaced hero worship of personalities getting timing forecasts wrong for tedious years on end. We'd appreciate it if they'd just admit those are paid promotions. Reading remarks at Silver Doctors from the rank and file and on You Tube, people are catching on---the interviewers and their merchandising guests are all out to bleed off as much income as possible from audiences whose minds they've successfully massaged for years. These nasty below the belt tricks of denying guests pay for their wares being boosted are losing traction however. This October 2018 item below suggests progress so people who donate will realize they're subsidizing people selling things to them---notice lower right hand corner and lower left! "Includes paid promotion" OKAY! This is VERY NEW and only came by way of official and unofficial inquiries and pressure from a small committee including me and a You Tube comment poster. Zang reps for a gold numismatic coin dealer. Does anyone seriously believe she gets interviews for ITM Trading all for free? How much inter-dealer trading goes on between ITM and Silver Doctors? No objection to inter-dealer trading! But would she be covered at SD without business relationship? Not likely! ITM refused response to my inquiry; I received torrid denial from Miles Franklin that money was paid to have Andy Hoffman boosted, regardless that he had at least 62 interviews on this channel--how many businesses do you know who are so GD smart they can get so much free advertising? I reject the denials of interviewers and guest personalities! This isn't human nature to provide free advertising to people marketing things! True,

the notice at left could refer to pop up ads, but it may also start someone wondering, "Is the entire session really just a paid ad," it's inexperienced and unreasonably trusting to believe otherwise.

Gold numismatics are remarkably bad instruments if needed for emergency barter money. Common date silver dimes are best and Mercury dimes are tops as no date check is needed; 1940-1945 issues are easiest to come by and have the least wear. I am happy to be swimming in dimes! No You Tube interviews (for which I'd earn zero income) and no linking of these unique research pieces, for two reasons 1) sites are very reluctant to allow discussion of specific persons involved in major scale organized conspiracies and 2) no one is accepted into the Circle of Peers in the precious metals and alt news community if they aren't offering something for purchase to the public. In September 2018 I broke with Mister Morgan and insisted my content removed after 17 years of association. His perennially bad silver price predictions have made him the laughingstock of many understandably cynical investors. Regardless as long as he can pay You Tube interview hosts like Silver Doctors, Reluctant Preppers, USA Watchdog, Palisade Radio, SGT Report and others for promotional sessions, he'll continue to be in their parlance a "returning guest." Marketing newsletter subscriptions appears to be virtually his sole reason for existing. Note that all "returning guests" are all peddling

things for purchase, despite that they and their interviewers all deny any payments made for these business boosting interviews. Interviewers do a magnificent job of massaging small intellects into slavishly hero worshipping characters like Lynette Zang, Catherine Austin Fitts, Gerald Celente, Rob Kirby, Harley Schlanger, Michael Pento, Jim Willie and the rest of the heel nipping pack of merchandisers. A free info provider like me does NOT fit into these circles! They're running advertising businesses; I'm not marketing anything for purchase; I am not "fit" to be interviewed ("promoted"). Dave Janda can't mention The Pilgrims Society on his show because too many people know I've been writing about it for years and years, and mine is the most banned name out there.
